Volunteer Service Description: A construction assistant will support the construction staff by joining them on site to accomplish daily tasks, help preparing for groups and finishing punch list items.

Training:

- Each Construction Assistant will join the construction staff onsite to learn techniques and skills needed.

Responsibilities:

- Assist construction staff with hands on projects
- Learn tools and techniques used by construction staff to perform duties on site.
- Assist construction staff with preparing for onsite groups

Volunteer Impact: This volunteer will play an essential role by assisting our construction staff onsite with regular duties. The construction crew will be able to quickly finish tasks and be able to move to other needed tasks with your assistance. Additionally, they will be able to plan for large groups to come onsite and ensure that all materials are ready for them. The homes will be complete at a faster rate allowing our families to move in.

Age Requirements: Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

Skill Qualifications: Must have a construction background but is willing to learn Habitat for Humanity's techniques for building. Must be able to lift at least 25lbs and have knowledge of power tools. A driver's license is also required.

Time Commitment: At least 9 hours per week

Training & Supervision: Provided by the Construction Staff
