

## **Habitat for Humanity of Greater Chattanooga Construction Safety Advisor: Volunteer Position**

**Volunteer Service Description:** Ensure Habitat for Humanity provides a fun but safe working environment on the construction site. With assistance of the construction staff, evaluate current safety program and develop new techniques to maintain a safe worksite for volunteers.

**Responsibilities:**

- Evaluate current safety program at Habitat for Humanity and research techniques used by other Habitat for Humanity affiliates.
- Incorporate new safety policies and procedures at Habitat for Humanity sites.
- Assist Director of Volunteers to create program for each group to have a safety advisor on site at all times.

**Volunteer Impact:** The volunteer will play a direct role in ensuring Habitat for Humanity operates a safe construction site. Developing a comprehensive program will allow Habitat for Humanity to maintain its reputation as a safe site operator and continue to provide volunteers with a good experience.

**Age Requirements:** Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

**Skill Qualifications:** Knowledge of OSHA safety rules and regulations is a plus as is being a volunteer for Habitat for Humanity. Flexibility and the ability to help with a variety of tasks that may arise are also needed.

**Time Commitment:** Volunteer hours at office and worksite may take place Tuesday – Saturday 9:00a – 4:00pm. Research can take place during own time.
