

## **Habitat for Humanity of Greater Chattanooga Crew Leader: Volunteer Position**

**Volunteer Service Description:** A Crew Leader is trained to assist the construction staff by working with a small group of volunteers and instructing them on tasks such as painting, installing trim or siding and framing.

### **Training:**

- Each volunteer will attend a half day orientation outlining the expectations and goals of crew leaders.
- Crew leaders will spend the necessary amount of time with the construction staff before supervising a group of volunteers

### **Responsibilities:**

- Assist Construction Staff with leading a small group of volunteers
- Instruct volunteers on correct methods for the task
- Follow all safety procedures outlined by Habitat for Humanity.

**Volunteer Impact:** Crew Leaders will help support the construction of our homes on multiple levels. Not only will Habitat be able to utilize more volunteers per weekend, but the homes will be completed at a quicker pace. Additionally, the construction staff can ensure the work on the house is properly performed and in a safe manner.

**Age Requirements:** Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

**Skill Qualifications:** Knowledge in construction techniques is preferred. Good interpersonal skills is a must along with the ability to teach others tasks.

**Time Commitment:** Volunteer hours will take place Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday from 8:45am – 3:30pm. Volunteer must commit to one day per month.

**Training & Supervision:** Provided by the Construction Committee & Staff
