Volunteer Service Description: Are you an outgoing, energetic person who has great communication skills? The ReStore is in need of someone who is willing to let businesses know that they can donate their items instead of throwing them into the landfill.

Responsibilities:

- Contact local businesses and tell them about partnering with the ReStore
- Keep records of businesses contacted and responses

Volunteer Impact: The volunteer will play a direct role in increasing sales in the ReStore. On a daily basis, businesses throw out literally tons of material that is still in useable condition. Informing these businesses about the services the ReStore provides will increase awareness, donations and eventually sales. The profits from the sale of items at the ReStore will go directly back into the community by enabling HFHGC to build more homes and serve more families.

Age Requirements: Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

Skill Qualifications: Great communications skills is a must. Knowledge of computers is necessary. Flexibility and the ability to help with a variety of tasks that may arise are also needed

Time Commitment: Volunteer hours will take place Tuesday - Friday 9:00a – 4:00p. We are looking for volunteers to commit to a minimum of one half day per week.
