

Habitat for Humanity of Greater Chattanooga ReStore Pricing Team: Volunteer Position

Volunteer Service Description: With donations coming in daily, the backroom can get swamped. Armed with a pricing guide and a pricing gun, the team sorts, prices, and sends the donations out to the floor. You never know what's coming in, and you'll be the first to see all the incredible stuff that people donate to the ReStore, from basic couches and sinks to Jet-Skis and church pews and everything in between!

Responsibilities:

- Check donations for acceptability using ReStore criteria.
- Price items using pricing guide
- Transfer items from receiving room to store

Volunteer Impact: The volunteer will play a direct role in increasing sales in the ReStore. Ensuring only quality items are on the sales floor will increase customer satisfaction. Having items priced consistently will deter people from “haggling”. Additionally, pricing items will allow customers to shop with more ease. The profits from the sale of items at the ReStore will go directly back into the community by enabling HFHGC to build more homes and serve more families.

Age Requirements: Volunteers must be at least 18 years old to volunteer alone. Adults must accompany volunteers aging 14-18 years old.

Skill Qualifications: Must have the ability to lift up to 25lbs. Flexibility and the ability to help with a variety of tasks that may arise are also needed

Time Commitment: Volunteer hours will take place Wednesday – Saturday 9:00a – 4:00p. We are looking for volunteers to commit to a minimum of one half day per week.
