

## **Habitat for Humanity of Greater Chattanooga Site Development Assistant: Volunteer Position**

**Volunteer Service Description:** Assist Habitat for Humanity with finding economically priced, buildable lots within the Chattanooga City Limits and Hamilton County.

**Responsibilities:**

- Research current market on weekly basis to find lots that match Habitat for Humanity's criteria.
- Visit prospective lots to visually determine if they meet criteria.

**Volunteer Impact:** The Site Development Assistant will play a direct role in ensuring Habitat for Humanity purchases lots that meet the needs of Habitat and the partner families. Assisting the Director of Construction and Land Development with this task will increase efficiency by allowing the construction staff to continue to focus on improving systems.

**Age Requirements:** Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

**Skill Qualifications:** A background in site development and construction is preferred. Flexibility and the ability to help with a variety of tasks that may arise are also needed.

**Time Commitment:** Volunteer hours at the office may take place Tuesday – Friday 9:00a – 4:00pm. Research can take place during own time.
