

## **Habitat for Humanity of Greater Chattanooga Youth United Coordinator: Volunteer Position**

**Volunteer Service Description:** Provide the youth of Chattanooga with an opportunity to make a difference in their community! The Youth United Coordinator will coordinate local schools and youth organizations to create an official Youth United program.

**Responsibilities:**

- Follow Habitat for Humanity International's guidelines to develop strong relationships with local schools and youth organizations
- Provide youth with opportunities to fundraise and learn about Habitat for Humanity

**Volunteer Impact:** The volunteer will play a direct role in creating an opportunity for youth to participate in their community. Those under the age of 16 currently cannot participate with Habitat for Humanity. The Youth United Coordinator create a program where youth can learn about community service at any age.

**Age Requirements:** Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

**Skill Qualifications:** Ability to connect with youth organizations and schools in Chattanooga is a must. Fundraising and coordination skills are preferred. Flexibility and the ability to help with a variety of tasks that may arise are also needed.

**Time Commitment:** Volunteer hours may take place Tuesday - Friday 9:00a – 4:00p. We are looking for volunteers to commit to a minimum of one half day per week.
